

Off-Licence Code of Practice

ARE YOU

18?

Did you know it is an offence to:

- Buy alcohol for a person under the age of 18
- Buy alcohol if you are under 18 years of age
- Claim to be over 18

Maximum fine **£5,000**

and/or imprisonment for up to six months

We'll only accept one of the following as evidence that you can buy alcoholic products:

- ▶ Driving licence with photo card
- ▶ Valid passport
- ▶ Electoral registration card

This premises supports the **Code of Practice** Initiative

- ▶ Staff will not sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 18
- ▶ Staff will not sell alcohol to intoxicated persons
