

It's coming- New improved brown bin Service **June/July 2010**

We are making improvements to the brown bin collection service. This will help you recycle more from your home and in doing so assist the Council in meeting its landfill diversion targets.

You will be provided with a kitchen caddy and a year's supply of biodegradable caddy liners. The liners should last until April 2011- this is based on using three a week. If you require additional liners during the year, these can be purchased from the Council - current price £0.80 for a roll of 30. If payment is being made by debit card there is a minimum payment of £5. Alternatively, you can line your caddy with a single sheet of newspaper, or use your caddy without any liner!

What can I put in my brown bin?

Garden waste is still collected along with all your food waste - cooked or raw! Meat & fish, vegetables & fruit, dairy products, bread, cakes, pastries, pasta, cereal, rice, beans, tea & coffee grounds, leftover food from your plate, even bones!



How to use your caddy and liners

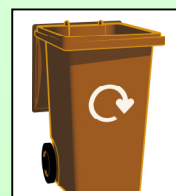

Line your caddy with the biodegradable liner and fill it with your food waste. Once it is full, tie the liner and place it in your brown bin.

IMPORTANT: Only use the liners provided - NO PLASTIC bags please!

If you wish you can line your caddy with a single sheet of newspaper or use it without any liner!
